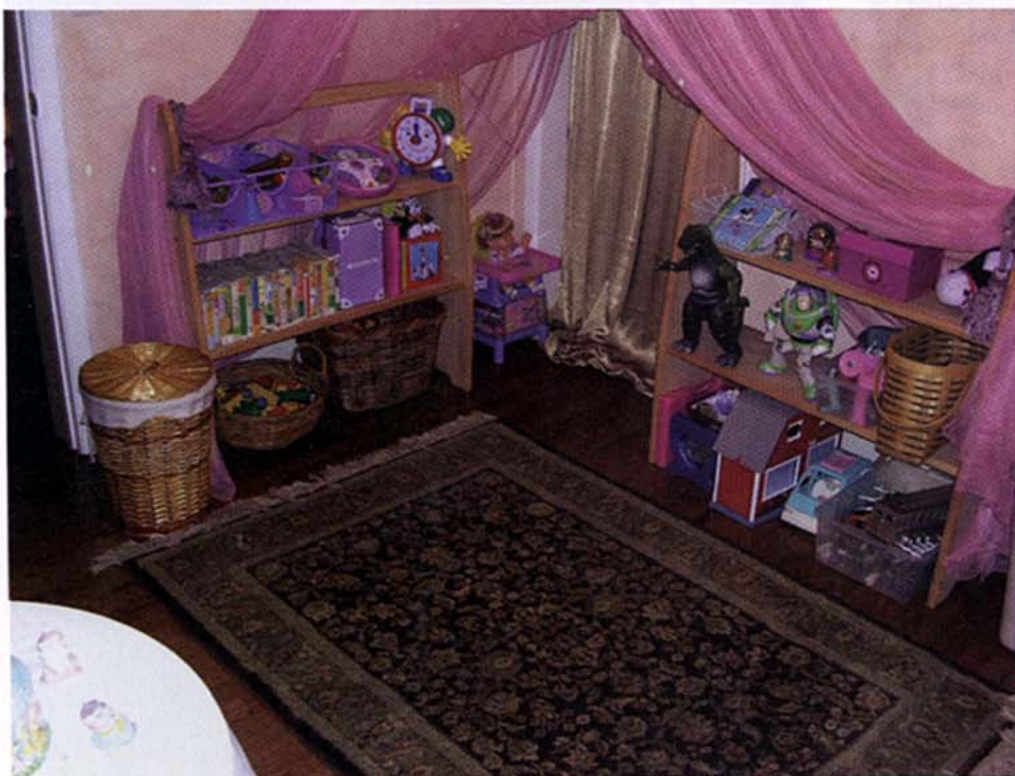
A person who wants to reduce the stress in their life and even the frustration and anxiety levels associated with having piles of 'stuff' surrounding them. Organizers to the
